Your answers to the questions below should demonstrate that ability generally and as it specifically relates to the mentored research project you would like to conduct.

1. Below please include a description (up to 1,000 words) of the HIV and/or drug use prevention research ethics topic you would like to examine for your Mentored Research Project (MRP). Your answer should demonstrate familiarity with contemporary issues in research ethics and provide sufficient detail for the RETI Selection Committee to evaluate the significance and feasibility of the project. *(Please note that we view this description as a preliminary basis for the final MRP that will be developed during the Institute since one of our primary goals is to expand fellows' knowledge of and skills to conduct empirical research on research ethics.)*

Your answer should include a brief description of the following:

- (a) Background and rationale
- (b) Specific aims of the project
- (c) Sample characteristics and sample size
- (d) Research design and brief plan for analysis
- (e) Feasibility of your completing the project including access to the participant population and sample size proposed, and the extent to which the research environment at your home institution will encourage or support this two-year project.
